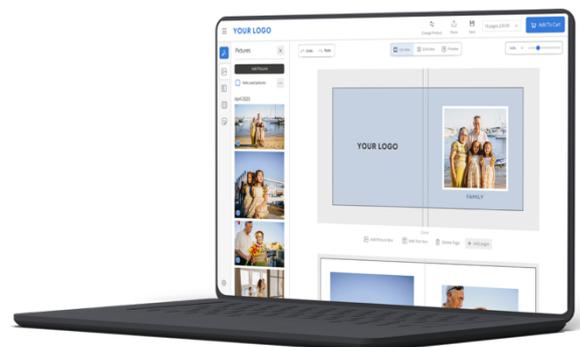
- Experience writing automated functional and regression tests using JavaScript.
